By the Administrative Law Judge:

The Court conducted a June 7, 2006 prehearing teleconference with Jeffrey S. Buckner, counsel for the Division of Securities, and James N. Barber, counsel for Respondents.

Respective counsel informed the Court that settlement negotiations have been considered as to possibly resolve this proceeding in lieu of a subsequent hearing, but no settlement has been realized and this proceeding should be set for hearing.

Accordingly, the Court and respective counsel scheduled the Division's disclosure of the relevant and non-privileged contents of its investigative file and its submission of witness and exhibit lists. The Court also scheduled Respondents' submission of witness and exhibit lists. Respective counsel informed the Court that neither party anticipates any prehearing motions and the anticipated duration of the hearing would be one (1) day. The Court and respective counsel then scheduled the hearing to be conducted in this proceeding.

Based on the foregoing, the Court entered an Order, the terms of which are restated as follows:

ORDER


The Division shall provide the relevant and non-privileged contents of its investigative file to Respondents by July 7, 2006. The Division shall similarly submit its witness and exhibit lists.

The witness list shall identify each possible witness and include a brief summary of their anticipated testimony. The exhibit list shall identify each potential exhibit. A copy of each exhibit shall also be provided to the extent it is not disclosed through the investigative file.

Respondents shall submit their witness and exhibit list to the Division by July 21, 2006. The witness list shall identify each possible witness and include a brief summary of their anticipated testimony. The exhibit list shall identify each potential exhibit. A copy of each exhibit shall also be provided to the extent it has not been identified by the Division.

The hearing in this proceeding shall commence at 9:00 a.m. on August 30, 2006 in Room 451 of the Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. The parties are granted leave to continue any pursuit of settlement negotiations as may be warranted. If any settlement becomes likely, respective counsel shall contact the Court to prompt another prehearing teleconference in this proceeding.
