Respondents Scott Lamar Rhoads, Zacharia Lamar Rhoads, and Auto Rama, LLC hereby submit their written response to the Order to Show Cause dated December 30, 2005.

FIRST DEFENSE

On information and belief, Respondents and each of them deny the allegations in the Order to Show Cause.

SECOND DEFENSE

A criminal case is currently pending in the Second District Court for the State of Utah captioned *State of Utah v. Scott L. Rhoads and Zacharia L. Rhoads*, Case Nos. 061902825, 061902826. The cases are being prosecuted by Neal Gunnarson, Assistant

Attorney General for the State of Utah. This case, also prosecuted by an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Utah subjects Respondents to Double Jeopardy.

THIRD DEFENSE

By requiring Respondents to file an Answer to the Order to Show Cause, the State of Utah has violated Defendants' fifth amendment right against self-incrimination. Respondents cannot be compelled to give evidence against themselves and, given the parallel criminal prosecution, by their First Defense above, do not waive the privilege and affirmatively assert the same.


FOURTH DEFENSE
