MOTION TO DISMISS



Petitioner, the Division of Securities (Division), by and through counsel, and pursuant to Rule 41(a)(2)(ii) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure to the extent they may be looked to as persuasive in this proceeding, UTAH ADMIN. CODE R151-46b-5(3), moves for dismissal of the Order to Show Cause filed in this matter on February 3, 2006 on grounds that protection of the public has been adequately served. On April 27, 2007, Jones pleaded no contest to securities fraud, a second degree felony, in a parallel proceedings. As part of sentencing, Jones was placed on probation and was ordered to pay \$20,000 in restitution for the related conduct in the Division's Order to Show

Cause. *State of Utah v. Dale Allen Jones*, Case No. 061901813, Third Judicial District Court of Utah (2006). The conviction, the penalty and the remedies sought therein adequately protect the public and serve the Division's interests. If Respondents do not pay the restitution, the public's interest in this matter would be adequately served by the remedy provided in the parallel proceedings for non compliance with the terms of probation. Rule 41(a)(2)(ii) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, to the extent persuasive in administrative proceedings before the Department, Utah Admin. Code R151-46b-5(3), allows a plaintiff to request a dismissal of an action on order of the court based upon such terms and conditions as the court deems proper.




