JAMIS MELWOOD JOHNSON**

Petitioner, the Division of Securities (Division), by and through counsel, and pursuant to Rule 41(a) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, Utah Admin. Code R151-46b-5(3), hereby moves for dismissal of the above-captioned Order to Show Cause filed on February 28, 2006, as to Respondent Jamis Melwood Johnson (Johnson). On March 7, 2007, Johnson was found guilty of one count of securities fraud, a second degree felony, in Case No. 051700056 by the Fourth Judicial District Court for the related conduct in the Division's Order to Show Cause. On March 18, 2011, Johnson was convicted by a jury of seven counts of mail fraud, nine counts of wire

fraud, one count of conspiracy, and ten counts of money laundering and aiding and abetting in Case No. 2:09-cr-00133-CW-3 in U.S. District Court of Utah. The conviction, the penalty and the remedies sought therein satisfy the Division. Rule 41(a)(2)(ii) of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, Utah Admin. Code R151-46b-5(3), allows a plaintiff to request a dismissal of an action on order of the court based upon such terms and conditions as the court deems proper.


