I, J.D. PULVER, having been sworn and being under oath, allege as follows:

1. I am the respondent in this order.
2. A default order was entered against me on June 20, 2007.
3. I did not file the required response to the Emergency Order in this matter

because I had retained attorneys Mr. George Parnell and his partner, Mr. Robert Zito to file the amended answers on my behalf that would be acceptable to the Division. The Division did not accept their amended response, either. My attorneys had advised me that this Emergency Order would not be dismissed unless I personally met with the Division of Securities. I terminated their representation of me because they had informed me that they did not have any jurisdiction in the state of Utah, but they continued to work on my case despite their lack of ability to assist me. I faxed a request on May 3, 2007 to meet with the division in person, as my attorneys had previously advised me to do. Mr. Jeffrey Buckner responded to my request on May 30, 2007 which directed me to file an amended response within ten days from that date. Mr. Buckner's response was sent by regular U.S. mail, however, and I did not receive it until


June 8, 2007. I telephoned Mr. Buckner on June 8, 2007 who stated he would send me my options in writing. I did not receive my options in writing until after the default order was entered against me.

4. I believe that I have valid legal defense to this Emergency Order. I have prepared an amended answer to the Emergency Order in the manner that the Division has directed me to respond. I also have additional documentation to prove my innocence. I also ask the Division to recognize that Tim Haskins and I CEASED and DESISTED any involvement with "Flavor Brands I" or "Flavor Brands II" long before the Division sent the Emergency Order in August of 2006. As; Attorney Barber who originally thought the trading entity and the company could be merged under Rule 145 then decided he didn't want to deal with the situation.
