

Code R151-46b-5(3), hereby moves for dismissal of the above-captioned Order to Show Cause filed on September 28, 2006. On February 13, 2009, Keyser pleaded guilty to three counts of attempted securities fraud, a class A misdemeanor, in Case No. 061907231 in the Third Judicial District Court for the related conduct in the Division's Order to Show Cause. 
