SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter came before Benjamin Johnson, the hearing officer designated by the presiding officer, as an initial hearing for scheduling further proceedings on July 5, 2007. The Division appeared through counsel and was represented by assistant attorney general Jeffrey Buckner. Jonathan Stewart also appeared on behalf of the Division. Scot Stobbe, Samuel Aston and Mascot Financial, LLC were not present and did not appear through counsel.

Procedural Background

The Division commenced agency action against Mascot Financial, LLC, Samuel Duane Aston, and Scot Stobbe on May 21, 2007 by issuing an Order to Show Cause. The Order to Show Cause and a Notice of Agency Action advised Respondents of a hearing on July 5, 2007, and the need to file a response within thirty days. A copy of the Notice of Agency Action and Order to Show Cause were served on Respondents by certified mail. The copy of the Order to Show Cause and Notice of Agency Action served on Stobbe was returned undelivered on May 29, 2007; the copy served on Aston was signed for as received by Aston on May 25, 2007; the copy served on Mascot

Financial at its business address was returned undeliverable on May 23, 2007. The copy was re-mailed to Stobbe's address on May 25, 2007 and was also returned undeliverable. Stobbe was the registered agent for the company.


Stobbe contacted the Division on June 18, 2007, and asked for a postponement of the hearing. He also later asked for additional time to file a response. Although he asked for additional time to respond, Stobbe subsequently e-mailed an unsigned copy of a response on June 28, 2007, saying a signed copy would follow, but he never filed or served a signed copy. The Division then agreed to give him 90 days to file an answer. The Division did not agree, however, to extend the time for Mascot Financial to file a response. The Division also did not agree to extend the time for Aston to file a response. No answer was filed by Aston or Mascot Financial. No contact was made in their behalf.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Default is entered against Respondent Samuel Aston for failure to respond.
2. Respondent Mascot Financial is given another ten calendar days from the entry date of this order to file a response.
3. Scot Stobbe is given until October 1, 2007 to file a response.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
