BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

On May 1, 2013, the parties to this matter stipulated to stay the administrative proceedings for four months in order to allow for an ongoing criminal case filed against Respondent Kitts to be resolved. Respondent was charged on July 19, 2007 in case number 071905099 (Third District Court, Salt Lake County, Utah) with numerous counts of securities fraud and theft, several of which remain pending.

In these circumstances, the presiding officer finds that a stay is warranted.

ORDER

The administrative proceedings in Division case numbers SD-07-0049, SD-07-0050, and SD-07-0051 are stayed for a period of up to four months from the date of this order.

If the criminal case herein referenced is resolved through entry of a plea of guilty or no contest, conviction, or dismissal within this four-month period, the stay shall be lifted, and the presiding officer will schedule an initial hearing. Respondent shall notify the Division within five (5) days of resolving the criminal case.

If the criminal case herein referenced is not resolved within this four-month period, the presiding officer will hold a status conference with the parties and determine how to move the administrative proceedings forward.
