

COME NOW, TIN CUP MINING CORPORATION and GILES H. FLORENCE, the Respondents in the above entitled matter and file a Motion to stay the above proceedings pending the resolution of criminal charges filed against Respondent, Giles H. Florence, regarding the same alleged victims and the same alleged facts as made by the Division of Securities in the above matter. The criminal information filed in Third District Court, Salt Lake County, is Case Number 081900760 and the Respondent, Giles H. Florence, plead not guilty on Monday, February 4, 2008 and a Public Defender has been appointed by the Court to represent Mr. Florence in that matter. The Court was also advised that Mr. Florence, who is 84 years old, has serious medical problems. Given the criminal charges against Mr. Florence, he will not be able to be a witness in the above pending matter without jeopardizing his constitutional

rights in the pending criminal matter. The criminal charges, if resolved by plea bargain or by a trial unfavorable to Mr. Florence, will address the alleged damages suffered by the alleged victims in the above entitled matter. To proceed further until the criminal charges are resolved will result in a duplication of effort and expense to the State of Utah and/or a serious injustice to Mr. Florence. At the Scheduling Conference held January 15, 2008, Defendants were not aware that criminal charges would be filed January 29, 2008. Although, after the scheduling meeting, the State's investigator made threats to Respondent's Attorney that he would possibly bring criminal charges. At the Scheduling Conference on January 15, 2008, the parties scheduled February 29, 2008 for the filing of Respondent's possible Motions, March 28, 2008, for a response and April 4, 2008 for a reply. Mr. Florence, at the current time, cannot afford to pay his legal counsel and if this matter is not stayed, his current counsel requests leave to withdraw. If the matter is stayed, Respondent's counsel reserves the right to withdraw depending upon Mr. Florence's financial situation after the criminal charges are resolved.
