
BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

On July 9, 2013, the parties to this matter executed a stipulation and consent order that, if approved by the Utah Securities Commission (Commission), will resolve all allegations raised in the pleadings to date. The stipulation and order will be presented to the Commission on August 14, 2013. In these circumstances, the presiding officer finds good cause to stay further administrative proceedings pending the Commission's review of, and decision regarding, the parties' stipulation. If the Commission approves the stipulation and enters the consent order, that action shall serve to dismiss all other proceedings that might otherwise be necessary to adjudicate and resolve the case. If the Commission rejects the stipulation, the presiding officer shall issue a notice setting a date and time for an initial hearing.

SCHEDULING ORDER

NOTICE OF HEARING

CASE NO. SD-08-0083

BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

The notice of agency action and order to show cause in this matter were sent by the Division of Securities (Division) to Evan McKay Nielson (Respondent) on August 13, 2008. In approximately September of 2008, the case was stayed pending the outcome of a parallel criminal case filed against Respondent. On June 3, 2013, the criminal case having been resolved through a plea in abeyance agreement, the stay was lifted. On July 3, 2013, Respondent timely filed his response to the order to show cause. An initial hearing was held on July 9, 2013.

The presiding officer now enters the following scheduling order:

1. The parties shall comply with the initial disclosure requirement of Utah

Administrative Code § R151-4-503

(<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T30>) by July 23, 2013.

2. Any motion for summary judgment, judgment on the pleadings, or other dispositive motion shall be filed no later than September 6, 2013. If any such motion is filed, the other party shall have ten calendar days from the date of filing to respond, and the moving party shall have five business days from the date of response to reply. *See* Utah Administrative Code §§ R151-4-303(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T22>) and R151-4-107(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T7>). If oral argument is required or requested on a dispositive motion, the presiding officer will issue a supplemental scheduling order setting a date and time.
3. The parties shall complete discovery by October 4, 2013.
4. Pursuant to Utah Administrative Code § R151-4-504(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T31>), the parties shall exchange final disclosures by October 4, 2013.
5. Should either party determine to use an expert witness, the party shall disclose the expert's name, contact information, and written report no later than November 4, 2013.
6. Unless this matter is settled through a stipulated agreement, resolved through an order issued on a prehearing motion, or continued for good cause, a hearing shall take place before the Utah Securities Commission on December 5, 2013.
