Respondents Capstone Equity Capital, LLC, Michael L. Bloxham and Jonathon R. Watts, by and through their counsel, J. Michael Coombs, Esq., hereby move the Administrative Law Judge for an order staying these proceedings.

The basis for this motion is that Division prosecutor Jennifer Korb has indicated to counsel that a "criminal referral" against these Respondents appeared to be forthcoming. She instructed counsel to call Charlene Barlow or Neal Gunnarson of the Financial Crimes Unit of the Utah Attorney General's office. Counsel called Mr. Gunnarson this week and spoke with him twice in the last two days. Mr. Gunnarson, after checking with paralegals and investigators,


indicated that a criminal investigation was being conducted and that because the investigation was not complete, there was, as yet, no actual criminal referral. He did indicate that the criminal prosecutor in the particular case would be Charlene Barlow and he further indicated that because these Respondents now had counsel, that Ms. Barlow would contact counsel at the time criminal charges would be brought or filed in an effort to resolve such proceedings without costly litigation.

In addition, Ms. Korb indicated to counsel that the Division ordinarily has no objection to staying administrative proceedings in the event that a criminal proceeding is or will be pending.

Based on the foregoing, these Respondents hereby respectfully request that these proceedings be stayed pending the resolution of any forthcoming criminal proceedings.


