COMES NOW the Respondent, Pat G. Miner, and responds to the Division's Order to Show Cause as follows:

1. Respondent Denies the allegations in paragraph 1.
 2. Respondent Admits the allegations in paragraph 2.
 3. Respondent is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraph 3, and therefore Denies the same.
 4. Respondent Admits the allegations in paragraph 4 related to residency and licensing.
- Respondent Denies the allegation that Miners and Bowers were associates from 2000 until 2009. Miner first associated with Bowers in 2002 and had no more dealings with him after 2005.

5. Respondent Denies that she solicited an investment from EW through Millennial Financial Group, Inc.

6. Respondent Denies the allegations in paragraph 6.

7. Respondent is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11, and therefore Denies the same.

8. Respondent has no recollection of the alleged lunch in Provo, Utah, and therefore denies the allegations in paragraphs 12, 13, and 14.

9. Respondent has no recollection of the alleged meeting in Utah County in April of 2005, and is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 15, 16, 17, and 18 and therefore denies the same.

10. Respondent has no recollection of the alleged agreement and addendum described in paragraphs 19 and 20, and is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 19 and 20, and therefore denies the same.

11. Respondent has no recollection of receiving the cashier's check described in paragraph 21, and is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraph 21, and therefore denies the same.

12. Respondent has no recollection of the meeting described in paragraphs 22, 23, and 24, and is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 22, 23, and 24, and therefore denies the same.

13. Respondent is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30, and therefore denies the same.

14. Miner admits that she received two checks from Bowers as reimbursement for expenses she had paid over several years and money that Bowers personally owed to her. Miner is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the other allegations in paragraph 31, and therefore denies the same.

14. Respondent Admits the allegations in paragraphs 32 and 33.

15. Respondent Denies the allegations in paragraph 34.

16. Respondent is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraphs 35 and 36, and therefore Denies the same.

17. Respondent Denies that she had a history of lawsuits and judgments. Miner was not involved with Bowers in any of the lawsuits described in paragraph 37. Miner Denies the allegations in paragraph 37.

18. Respondent is without sufficient information or knowledge to form an opinion regarding the allegations in paragraph 38, and therefore Denies the same.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

1. The Divisions' Order to Show Cause fails to state a claim against Respondent, Pat G. Miner, upon which relief can be granted.


2. Respondent, Pat G. Miner, has no prior history of violations of the Utah Uniform Securities Act.


