The comments herein are referenced to their corresponding Discovery pages as facing pages, a comment page on the left and the document page on the right side.

The intent is to begin the process of evaluation of the statements and documents provided in the Mansfield Discovery in light of additional evidence which is presented as added sections beginning with Addendum 1 which follows this section.

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This email and its contents were not known to Mansfield until it was provided in these discovery documents.

This email is a very strong pitch by Debra Hobbins, wife of Douglas Kay Furr, as she indicates in the email.

This email is addressed to Margaret Sabey who subsequently invested \$2,000 in NuTorque, as shown in later pages of the discovery documents.

Debra Hobbins comments to the addressees of the email, one of which is Margaret Sabey, are fraudulent, misleading and are not at all representative of the proper claims and representations of NuTorque. Granted, Ms. Hobbins probably believed what she wrote in this email, but it is obvious that certain parts, at least, must have come from her husband, Douglas Kay Furr.

In **Addendum 1**, submitted with this commented document related to the Discovery Documents, Mansfield refutes the statements that Douglas Kay Furr is a legitimate PhD mechanical engineering or that he was a nominee for the Nobel Prize, both statements being false and fraudulent.

Doug Furr does have his name on five patents as of this writing, that are listed with the US Patent Office. None of these patents are technological breakthroughs, but rather deal with simple modifications and are questionable as to their financial value. Certainly nothing contained within that would be expected from someone claiming to have a PhD in Mechanical Engineering. This can be verified by anyone that is technically competent in the mechanical field.

The paragraph in the email beginning with the comments regarding 160 mpg and subsequent are pure conjecture, false and misleading, totally out of context or just patently false and are not at all representative of NuTorque's or Mansfield's information provided to any investors or potential investors.

The rest of the email is strictly Debra Hobbin's version of things and contains some mistakes, but the key element of note is that regardless of her statements that she is not soliciting, she really is soliciting and promoting this investment because of her husband's involvement with NuTorque and to promote their, Debra and Doug's, value in the company.

Debra's financial relationship with Doug can be confirmed by obtaining a copy of their prenuptial agreement, which Mansfield confirms exists because he typed it for them.

Dearest Colleagues:

The following is hard to believe. I am putting it out there because I love you, what you do with the info is totally up to you, without any effect on our relationship.

My husb, Doug, is PhD mechanical engineering. He has lots of patents: bullet for military, food storage stackers, vegetable capsules that allowed over 20 meds that could never be in capsule form to be manufactured (nominated for nobel prize, ended up finally 137 out of 1000 (in the late 80's I think), and universal release snowboard bindings, among others.

He and his partners are working on an engine that gets 160 mpg that will totally change the world. I know, sounds nuts, but I've seen the engine, the designing of the parts, starting the engine, etc. Doug is amazing—he comes up with improvement ideas in the middle of the nite, and all kinds of stuff. He is like a composer. with music that just flows out of the brain onto paper. With Doug, these mechanical things, amazing ideas, just flow out of his brain. Anyway, they have contacts in China, Bangladesh wants to contract with them to do energy stuff for the country, Australian air force wants them to use the engine to develop hover craft over water, mercedes and alcoa and others I don't even know of call them daily to give millions and be part of this amazing thing. The secretary of energy is in touch with his partner, Al Gore knows, Anyway, it would take a long time to tell everything, and I'm really not trying to convince you, anyway. That's not the purpose of this.

Doug and his partners have the money they need from the big investors, What is happening now is that before they sign up the big investors, they are having a friends and family offering of stock. With stock, there is always a risk and nothing is certain. However, I feel totally confident that the engine will be everything and more and they will all become gazillionaires. I wanted to tell you because I wanted you to have a chance to buy in and become financially free. We don't "need" the \$2K-50K people are putting in, we have the big boy investors lined up and are, in fact, selecting who we want to partner with.

Per the securities and exchange commission, the company can only have 35 small investors. I am letting some of my good friends know so that if they want to play, they can buy the stock now for \$2/share. When it goes to the big investors, it will be \$5/share, within 6 mo or so, it should be much higher, and a couple of years from now, we anticipate, well, the sky's the limit.

With all this \$, I want to be in charge of a foundation, and have a global perpetual education fund; fund clinics in Africa; would love a factory in Afganistan so the people can make money legit, allowing us to wipe out the poppy fields; industry; set up sub abuse treatment centers, provide prenatal care, OK, you all know me...

I feel like I am between a rock and a hard place. I don't want to be perceived as soliciting

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Debra Hobbins comments continue to be a strong appeal for investment without proper disclosure because she is apparently unaware of her husband's history and the fraudulent statements he has made to her. The key issue is that she is financially connected to her husband, both through the prenuptial agreement and later when she aids her husband through use of the division's stipulation record to reverse the attitude of her friends and family to turn from NuTorque and to support emotionally if not financially the efforts of Doug Furr and her in their new engine venture.

Intended by Debra, or not, the result is first:

Promote excessively the NuTorque project because Doug Furr has a financial interest in NuTorque.

Doug Furr seeks to negotiate a stronger position for himself and to further demonstrate to his new wife his importance and potential.

Included in these efforts, Doug Furr proposes his own engine concepts which had to be rejected (after detailed review by Mansfield and Bob Campbell from UVU) because they were seriously flawed. This, at the time was not a concern because the reason for Doug presenting his ideas were considered an honest effort, rather than what they really were, a power play.

Further, Doug Furr requested that Mansfield arrange to purchase a one million dollar home for Doug and Debra so Doug could live nearer to his work. When this suggestion had to be turned down because there was no legitimate way for NuTorque to use investor money for a personal expense, especially that large.

What wasn't realized at the time, was what Doug was after, a very dominant position and financial reward far beyond his capabilities or contribution to the company and the investors.

from my friends. My purpose in contacting you is simply from the heart, to share the blessings we will be receiving.

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Only the first page of these emails are presented here because page 321 is a copy of the email already presented on pages 318 / 319.

The first part of page 320 shows two short emails. The first from Debra Hobbins to Margaret Sabey followed by a reply from Margaret Sabey.

The first email is obviously a continuation of Debra's pitch to Margaret. The described offering details are quite different from what NuTorque proposed and her version was not provided by NuTorque. Also, it is notable that at this time, Debra had a considerably different opinion of Mansfield than she reported later.

In the second email, Margaret Sabey indicates that she is sold on Debra's pitch. This email precedes the email from Debra (page 324) setting up the meeting with Debra's friends and family, which is an indication that the people approached by Debra Hobbins were so inclined to buy that they were not looking too hard at what Mansfield tried to convey to insure they were adequately informed.

This message was sent with high importance.
