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On July 12, 2011, the Division issued an Order to Show Cause against Respondents. The Notice of Agency Action accompanying the Order to Show Cause set a hearing for September 7, 2011. On September 22, 2011, Respondents Ridgeland Wyoming, Inc., Bryan R. Farris and Gary Frank Lawyer requested a stay of the administrative proceedings. An Order granting Respondents' request for stay was entered on September 23, 2011. The Division moved to lift the stay and requested a trial date and scheduling order on February 7, 2012. A scheduling conference was conducted on February 14, 2012.


At the scheduling conference on February 14, 2012, the Division was represented by D. Scott Davis from the Office of the Attorney General and Thomas Brady from the Division. Mark D. Stubbs and Joseph M. Hepworth appeared on behalf of Ridgeland Wyoming, Inc., Bryan R. Farris and Gary Frank Lawyer. Mark W. Pugsley appeared on behalf of VYSN Capital, LLC and Shawn Blaine Smart. A schedule was set for further proceedings in this case.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Respondents shall file answers by March 22, 2012.

2. The parties shall exchange evidence by April 5, 2012.
3. Any dispositive motions, such as motions to dismiss or for summary judgment, shall be filed by May 15, 2012. If such motions are filed, the other party shall submit responses by June 5, 2012 and the moving party shall have two (2) weeks after the filing of a response to reply. If oral argument on such motions is requested, a hearing shall be calendared and noticed.
4. Parties shall complete discovery and provide witness and exhibit lists to opposing parties and the Presiding Officer by May 1, 2012. Each side shall also identify any expert witnesses it intends to use and provide the other side with a copy of the expert's report by May 1, 2012.
5. An evidentiary hearing on the matter shall be held on July 2012. A specific date will be set and noticed at a later date.


