**BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:**

The notice of agency action and order to show cause in this matter were sent by the Division of Securities (Division) to the above-named Respondents on December 13, 2011. On January 26, 2012, counsel Brett L. Tolman filed an entry of appearance on behalf of Respondent Maynard. On January 31, 2012, Timothy Provost filed an answer through his counsel, Rudy J. Bautista. On February 1, 2012, the presiding officer who was initially assigned in this matter issued a scheduling order setting March 1, 2012 as the deadline for Respondent Maynard to file and answer, and scheduling a hearing for May 24, 2012. On March 1, 2012, counsel Eric G. Benson filed an entry of appearance on behalf of Respondent Maynard. According to the records

available to the presiding officer who is now assigned in this matter, Respondent Maynard has not filed an answer. A hearing was not held on May 24, 2012; there is nothing in the records available to the presiding officer to explain why.

In these circumstances, the presiding officer finds it appropriate to issue the following scheduling order:

1. Respondent Maynard shall file an answer to the Division's order to show cause within 30 days of the mailing date of this scheduling order. Consult Utah Administrative Code § R151-4-107 in calculating this deadline. Failure to comply with this deadline for answer shall constitute grounds for entry of a default order against Respondent Maynard without further notice or proceeding.
2. An initial hearing will be conducted on April 9, 2013 at the office of the Utah Division of Securities, located in the Heber Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Salt Lake City, Utah, at 9:30 A.M. At the initial hearing, the presiding officer will establish dates and deadlines for making prehearing disclosures, completing discovery, filing any prehearing motions, and conducting a hearing before the Utah Securities Commission.
3. Failure to attend the initial hearing shall constitute grounds for entry of a default order against Respondents without further notice or proceeding.
