**EMERGENCY ORDER TO CEASE
AND DESIST and ORDER TO SHOW
CAUSE**

This matter comes before the Director of the Utah Division of Securities (the "Division") on allegations of Division staff that Maverick Mining Company, Inc., Mark Bowman, and Bret Bowman, (collectively, "Respondents"), acting directly or indirectly through their agents, have engaged in acts and practices which violate the Utah Uniform Securities Act, Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-1, et seq. (the "Act"). Having been advised of relevant facts discovered in the course of the Division's investigation of this matter, the Director finds and concludes that Respondents' conduct presents an immediate and significant danger to the public welfare, and that the threat requires immediate action by the Division. The Director issues this Emergency Order in accordance with the provisions of Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-502. The Director further issues

this Order to Show Cause in accordance with the provisions of Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-20(1).

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

In support of this Emergency Order and Order to Show Cause, the Division's staff has received evidence establishing the following facts:

RESPONDENTS

- A. Maverick Mining Company, Inc. ("Maverick Mining") is a Utah corporation and the issuer of equity securities.
- B. Mark Bowman is the chief executive officer and chairman of the board of directors of Maverick Mining.
- C. Bret Bowman is the president of Maverick Mining and serves on the board of directors.

SOLICITATIONS

- D. Within the one year period from February 5, 2009 until February 5, 2010, Respondents, individually or through their agents, sold securities in Maverick Mining to approximately 16 Utah residents.
- E. Respondents, individually or through their agents, continue to solicit investments in Maverick Mining through the sale of its equity securities.

REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS

- F. The equity securities offered by Respondents, either directly or indirectly through their agents, are securities under Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-13(1)(ee)(i)(B).
- G. Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-7 states:

It is unlawful for any person to offer or sell any security in this state unless it is registered under this chapter, the security or transaction is exempted under Section 61-1-14, or the security is a federal covered security for which a notice filing has been

made pursuant to the provisions of Section 61-1-15.5.

- H. The securities offered and sold by Respondents, directly or indirectly through their agents, are not registered with the Division and do not appear to qualify for any exemption from registration, as provided in Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-14.
- I. Respondents are therefore in violation of Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-7.

DANGER OF IMMEDIATE HARM TO THE PUBLIC

- J. The Division believes, based on the continued sales activities of the Respondents, that the Respondents, either directly or indirectly through their agents, will continue to sell unregistered securities in the state of Utah.

EMERGENCY ORDER

In light of the foregoing, and in order to prevent or avoid danger to the public welfare, it is hereby ORDERED in accordance with Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-502 that:


1. Respondents, together with their employees, agents, affiliates, assignees, successors, and associated entities, shall immediately CEASE AND DESIST from offering or selling securities in this State, and from directly or indirectly aiding or assisting other individuals or entities from offering or selling securities in this State.
2. Respondents, together with their employees, agents, affiliates, assignees, successors, and associated entities, shall immediately CEASE AND DESIST from any and all other or further violations of the Act.
3. Respondents are advised that, pursuant to the Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-21, any violation of this Emergency Order is punishable as a third-degree felony.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Director, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-20, hereby orders Respondents to appear at a formal hearing to be conducted in accordance with Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-202 and 63G-4-204 through -209, and held before the Division. The hearing will occur on **Wednesday, June 6, 2012, at 9:00 A.M.**, at the office of the Utah Division of Securities, 160 East 300 South, Second Floor, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111. The Division will be represented by Assistant Attorney General D. Scott Davis, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111. Respondents may elect to be represented by counsel. If any Respondent fails to appear at the hearing, an order to cease and desist may be issued and a fine imposed by default against that Respondent, as provided by Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-206 or -209. At the hearing, Respondents may show cause, if any they have:


1. Why Respondents should not be ordered permanently to cease and desist from engaging in any further conduct in violation of Utah Code Ann. § 61-1-7 or any other section of the Act;
2. Why Respondents should not be ordered to pay fines to the Division in amounts to be determined at the hearing.


