
On June 26, 2012, the Division issued an Order to Show Cause against Respondent. At the initial hearing on November 7, 2012, the Division was represented by Thomas Brady from the Division. James Lee Anderson appeared on his own behalf. A schedule was set for further proceedings in this case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The parties shall file initial disclosures by January 7, 2013.
2. The parties shall exchange evidence by January 7, 2013.
3. The parties shall identify any expert witnesses and provide the other side with a copy of the expert's report by February 1, 2012.
4. Any dispositive motions, such as motions to dismiss or for summary judgment, shall be filed by February 15, 2013. If such motions are filed, the other party shall submit responses by March 1, 2013 and the moving party shall have five (5) days after the filing of a response to reply. If oral argument on such motions is requested, a hearing shall be calendared and noticed.
5. Parties shall provide witness and exhibit lists to opposing parties and the Presiding Officer by March 1, 2012.

6. An evidentiary hearing on the matter shall be held on March 28, 2013 at 9:00 a.m.


