BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

An initial hearing was held in this matter on February 6, 2013 for the purpose of establishing a hearing date and setting deadlines for all prehearing disclosure and discovery. During that meeting, the parties indicated that they anticipated resolving this matter through stipulation. Accordingly, no firm deadline was established for Respondents to file an answer to the Division's notice of agency action and order to show cause.

On April 9, 2013, the Division filed a motion requesting a firm deadline by which Respondents would be required to answer the allegations set forth in the order to show cause, none having been received as of that date. On April 15, 2013, the presiding officer sent Respondents a notice setting forth April 18, 2013 as the deadline to file a response to the Division's motion. Respondents did not respond.


It appears to the presiding officer that negotiations between the Division and the Respondents regarding a stipulated agreement have broken down. In these circumstances, it is necessary to take the matter to hearing. In order to proceed to hearing on a formal basis, it is necessary for the parties to conduct discovery and exchange disclosures. Therefore, the presiding officer finds it proper to require Respondents to file an answer or risk default.

Given the foregoing, the presiding officer now grants the Division's motion and sets May 3, 2013 as the deadline by which Respondents shall file their answer. Respondents bear the full responsibility to mail or otherwise deliver their answer in a timely manner, and such that it is received by the Division on or before May 3, 2013. If Respondents fail to comply with this deadline, the presiding officer will issue an order recommending default without any further notice to Respondents, and the hearing on May 30, 2013 will be conducted for the sole purpose of reviewing the recommendation for default.

This order shall be effective on the signature date below.
