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**BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:**

On June 18, 2013, the above-named Respondents, by and through their counsel of record Michael D. Esplin, filed a motion to stay the administrative proceedings in this matter. Respondent urges the stay in order to allow for an ongoing criminal case filed against Respondent Jackson to be concluded. Respondent Jackson was charged on April 25, 2012 in case number 121401193 (Fourth District Court, Utah County, Utah) with two counts of second degree felony securities fraud and two counts of second degree felony theft. As of the date of this order, the criminal case is active.

It appears that the criminal charges arise from the same allegations set forth in the order to show cause issued December 10, 2012 in this administrative matter. Further, it appears that

significant judicial, administrative, and state resources would be saved by allowing the criminal case to conclude before proceeding with the administrative action. Finally, the Utah Division of Securities does not oppose the motion for stay. In these circumstances, the presiding officer finds that granting the motion for stay is warranted.


**ORDER**

The administrative proceedings in Division case numbers SD-12-0071 and SD-12-0073 are stayed. The stay shall remain in effect until criminal case number 121401193 as herein specified has been resolved through entry of a plea of guilty or no contest, conviction, or dismissal. Respondent shall notify the Division within ten (10) days of resolving the criminal case.
