**SCHEDULING ORDER**

**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER:**

The notice of agency action and order to show cause in this matter were initially sent by the Division of Securities (Division) to the above-named Respondent on January 8, 2013. A prehearing conference was held on March 18, 2013. At the prehearing conference, Respondent represented that he never received the Division's mailing. In these circumstances, the Division provided Respondent with the notice of agency action and order to show cause during the prehearing conference and agreed to consider March 18, 2013 as the date of filing.

The presiding officer now enters the following scheduling order:

1. Respondent shall file an answer to the Division's order to show cause by April 17, 2013. In order for the answer to be considered timely filed, Respondent shall ensure


that it is received by the Division on or before April 17, 2013. Respondent may file his answer by e-mail if he so chooses.

2. The parties shall comply with the initial disclosure requirement of Utah Administrative Code § R151-4-503 (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T30>) by May 1, 2013.
3. The parties shall complete discovery by June 21, 2013.
4. Any motion for summary judgment, judgment on the pleadings, or other dispositive motion shall be filed no later than July 10, 2013. If any such motion is filed, the other party shall have ten calendar days from the date of filing to respond, and the moving party shall have five business days from the date of response to reply. *See* Utah Administrative Code §§ R151-4-303(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T22>) and R151-4-107(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T7>). If oral argument is required or requested on a dispositive motion, the presiding officer will issue a supplemental scheduling order setting a date and time.
5. Should either party determine to use an expert witness, the party shall disclose the expert's name, contact information, and written report no later than July 10, 2013.
6. Pursuant to Utah Administrative Code § R151-4-504(2) (<http://www.rules.utah.gov/publicat/code/r151/r151-04.htm#T31>), the parties shall exchange final disclosures by August 12, 2013.
7. Unless this matter is settled through a stipulated agreement, resolved through an order issued on a prehearing motion, or continued for good cause, a hearing shall take place before the Utah Securities Commission on September 26, 2013.

This order shall be effective on the signature date below.


